### How To Become A Client

**STEP ONE:** Look online at [www.probonopartner.org](http://www.probonopartner.org) to see if your organization is eligible for services and, if so, submit a Request for Legal Assistance.

**STEP TWO:** A Pro Bono Partnership staff attorney will set up a screening meeting (with preferably two board members from your organization) to determine whether your organization is eligible and to identify any outstanding legal needs.

**STEP THREE:** If you nonprofit qualifies, we will connect your organization with a Pro Bono Partnership staff attorney or volunteer attorneys from law firms or corporations who can help you with your legal matters.
