INTRODUCE STUDENTS TO THE POWER OF CREATIVITY!

- **Movement Matters - Grades served: 1 – 4**

Students explore concepts such as space, time and energy through creative movement in this residency. As they experiment with rhythm, tempo, shapes, levels and more, students develop locomotive skills and creative expression while learning about math and science.

- **Explore-A-Story - Grades served: 1 – 4**

This program helps young storytellers deepen their understanding of story structure and character development as they work together to write and perform their own tales.

- **Musical Theatre Dance –Grades 1 – 4**

Explore the wonderful world of musical theater through the genre of dance. Young learners will learn how the choreographer of a musical supports telling of the story.

- **Devised Theater Improv - Grades served: 1 - 4**

Students will learn about creating a scene through improvisation. This class is perfect for building collaborative skills in a fun and exciting way.

- **Voice Jam - Grades served: 1-4**

Students will learn to sing properly and enjoy ensemble singing in this fun-filled musical class.

- **Vocal Music - Grades served: 5 – 8**

Students will learn skills needed to be a professional singer (including breathing, song interpretation and tone quality)

- **Devised Theater - Grades served: 5 – 8**

In this residency, students hone their acting, playwriting and cooperation skills as they create an original theater piece.

- **Poetic Justice - Grades served: 5 – 8**

This residency encourages young people to discover their own unique voices by writing poetry about issues that are important to them and their communities. In addition to developing writing skills, young poets will learn how to present their work with confidence and style.

- **Musical Theater Dance - Grades served: 5 - 8**

Explore the wonderful world of musical theater through the genre of dance. Students will learn how the choreographer of a musical supports telling of the story.

- **Hip Hop Dance - Grades served: 5 – 8**

Students explore the roots of an art form that has inspired generations of young people and transformed the landscape of American culture. By focusing on various elements of hip hop students will gain an understanding of how young people created a movement that changed the world.
